Teddy Bear Box



DELTA CERAMCOAT ACRYLIC PAINTS

Black, Burnt Umber, Cadet Blue, Dark Foliage Green, Fiesta Pink, Heritage Green, Light Ivory, Spice Tan, Wild Rice

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cut box from 1/2" pine or birch plywood. Sides are 4-1/8" x 1-1/2". Bottom is 6-3/4" x 1-1/2". Glue and nail box together.

PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS

Sand box, then seal and stain if you wish.

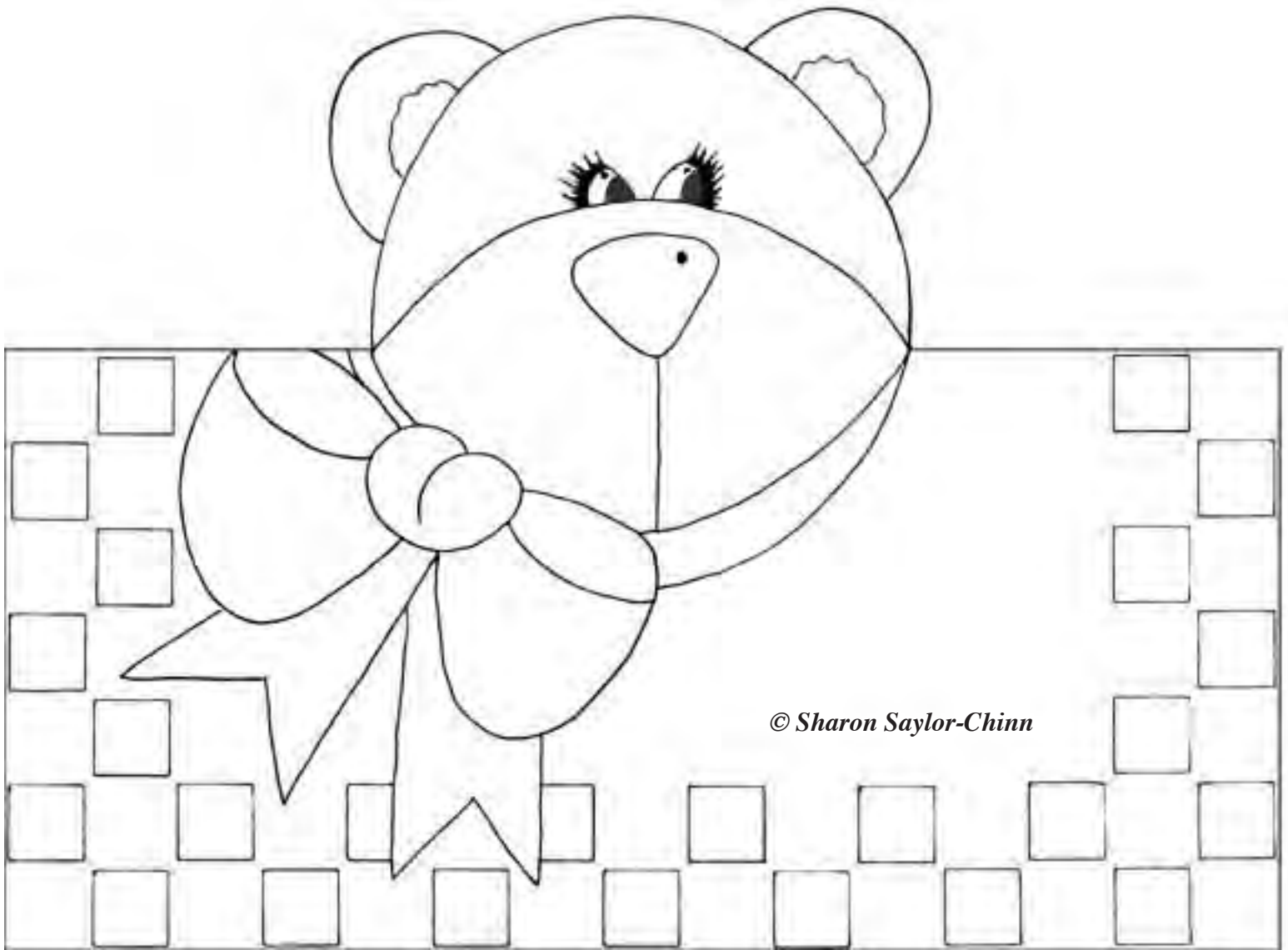
Bear... Base with WILD RICE, float shade with SPICE TAN. Drybrush highlight muzzle with LIGHT IVORY. Blush cheeks above muzzle and inside ears with a float of FIESTA PINK. Base eyes with BURNT UMBER. Pupil and lashes

are BLACK. Dot highlight with LIGHT IVORY. Base nose with a wash of BURNT UMBER. Float shade left side with BLACK, and blush right side with float of FIESTA PINK. Dot highlight with LIGHT IVORY.

Bow... Base with HERITAGE GREEN. Shade with float of DARK FOLIAGE GREEN. Highlight with LIGHT IVORY.

Checks... Base with CADET BLUE using a 1/2" flat brush. Float shade left side of each check with BLACK.

Outline detail with BLACK using a fine liner brush, or use a .01 Micron Pigma Pen. Varnish with a matte brush on or spray varnish.
