Requirements for Notice of Copyright Infringement

Following is The Decorative Painting Store policy regarding copyright disputes between artists/designers.

We cannot and will not pass judgment on alleged copyright violation(s) brought to our attention. Copyright disputes that arise between artists/designers whose patterns we sell must be settled by the parties involved and the appropriate legal authority. It is the sole responsibility of the parties involved to pursue such an investigation. If completed documentation of an alleged copyright infringement as outlined below is submitted, we will provide the documentation to the artist/designer who is being accused and remove the contested patterns from our store. Removal of patterns being disputed should in no way be construed as our taking sides in the dispute, we are required to do so by law upon receiving a completed notice of copyright infringement. If the patterns involved in both sides of the dispute are in our store, both will be removed until the dispute is settled.

Copyright infringement notices must include the following details. Until this complete information is submitted, we will be unable to take action on your request to remove patterns from our store:

Please create a separate attachment page for each of your infringement complaints with your copyrighted design info and photos along with all the information outlined in items 1 and 2.

4. You must agree to and affirm to both of the following statements by signing this statement.

A. I have a good faith belief that the pattern(s) described by my attachments to this statement as allegedly infringing is/are not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.

B. The information in this notification is accurate and I swear, under penalty of perjury, that I am the copyright owner or am authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive copyright that is allegedly infringed.

If you are not the copyright owner, you need to provide a statement by the copyright owner that you are authorized to act on their behalf.

Complete complaints require a physical or electronic signature of the copyright owner or a representative authorized to act on their behalf. To satisfy this requirement, you may type your full legal name to act as your signature at the bottom of your complaint.

Once documentation is completed and submitted to us, we will provide a complete copy of your documentation to the artist/designer you are claiming made the infringement, and the disputed patterns will be removed from our store. The two parties involved will then be responsible for any further action to resolve their issue.
